**AN ACT** to provide for the services of The Gambia from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2013.

[1<sup>st</sup> January 2013]

**ENACTED** by the President and the National Assembly.

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2013 and comes into force on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013.

Expenditure of D5,994,603,477 out of the authorised Consolidated Revenue Fund


2. There may be issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2013, both dates inclusive, **D5,994,603,477.00** (Five Billion, Nine Hundred and Ninety Four Million, Six Hundred and Three Thousand, Four Hundred and seventy seven dalasis), for the purposes specified in the Schedule to this Act.


