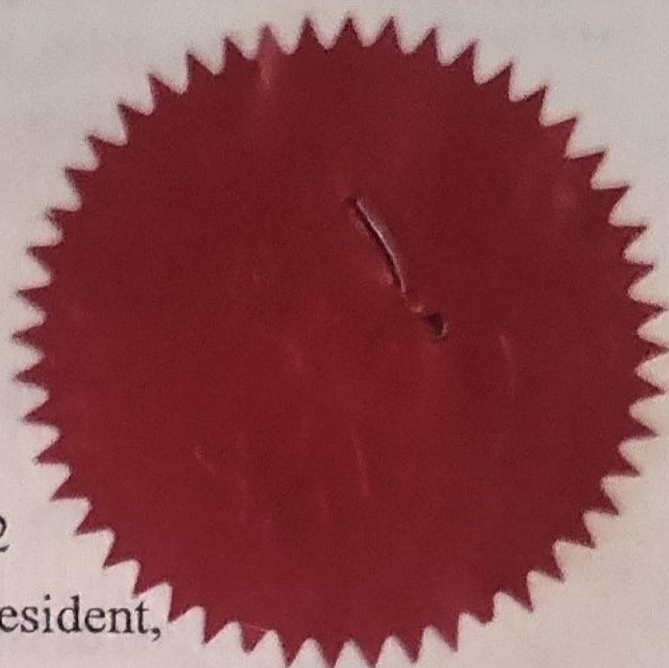

AN ACT to provide for the services of The Gambia from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the period 1st January 2012 to 31st December 2012.

[1st January 2012]

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2012 and comes into force on 1st January 2012.

2. There may be issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund during the period 1st January 2012 to 31st December 2012, both dates inclusive **D3,816,327,567** (Three Billion, Eight Hundred and Sixteen Million, Three Hundred and Twenty-seven Thousand, Five Hundred and Sixty-seven dalasis), for the purposes specified in the Schedule to this Act.





AN ACT to amend the Women's Act, 2010 and for connected matters.

[]

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Women's (Amendment) Act, 2012.

2. Amendment of Act No. 12 of 2010

The Women's Act, 2010, (in this Act referred to as the "Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Act.

3. Amendment of section 58


The principal Act is amended in section 58 (1) by –

- (a) deleting the word “and” immediately after the full stop in paragraph (b);
- (b) replacing the full stop in paragraph (c) with a semi-colon and adding the word “and” after the semi-colon; and
- (c) adding the following new paragraph “(d) the Ministry responsible for Women’s Affairs”.
