

**AN ACT** to provide for the services of The Gambia from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2009 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2010.

[1<sup>st</sup> January 2010]

**ENACTED** by the President and the National Assembly.

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2010 and comes into force on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010.

2. There may be issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2010, both dates inclusive, the sum of three billion, seven hundred and eighteen million, nine hundred fifty-two thousand six hundred twenty-nine dalasis, for the purposes specified in the Schedule to this Act.




