AN ACT to provide for the repeal of National Planning Commission Act, 2006 and for matters connected therewith.

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly of the Republic of the Gambia.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Planning Commission (Repeal) Act, 2010.

2. (1) The National Planning Commission Act, No 35 of 2006 is repealed and membership of the Commission established under it is consequently dissolved.


(2) The repeal of the enactment specified in subsection (1) does not affect anything done or purported to have been done under the Enactment.

3. All the rights, assets, liabilities, interests and obligation of the Commission are transferred to the Ministry of Economic Planning and Industrial Development.


4. By virtue of the commencement of this Act all staff of the Commission are to be absorbed by the Ministry of Economic Planning and Industrial Development.

5. Every order, requirement, certificate, notice, authorization, consent, application, request or thing made, issued, given or done under the repealed Act, shall if in force at the commencement of this Act and so far as it could have been made, issued, given or done under this Act, continues in force and have effect as made, issued, given or done under the corresponding provisions of this Act.

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act, 2010.

2. There may be issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund during the period 1st January 2010 to 31st December 2010, both dates inclusive, additional sums of money amounting to one hundred million dalasis, for the purposes specified in the Schedule to this Act.


