AN ACT to amend the National Assembly Salaries and Pensions Act, 1997 and for matters connected therewith.

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly Salaries and Pensions (Amendment) Act, 2007 and is deemed to have come into force on 30th January, 2002.

2. The National Assembly Salaries and Pensions Act, 1997 is amended, in sections 4 and 5 (1), by substituting for the words "twelve and a half", wherever they occur, the word "twenty-five".


