

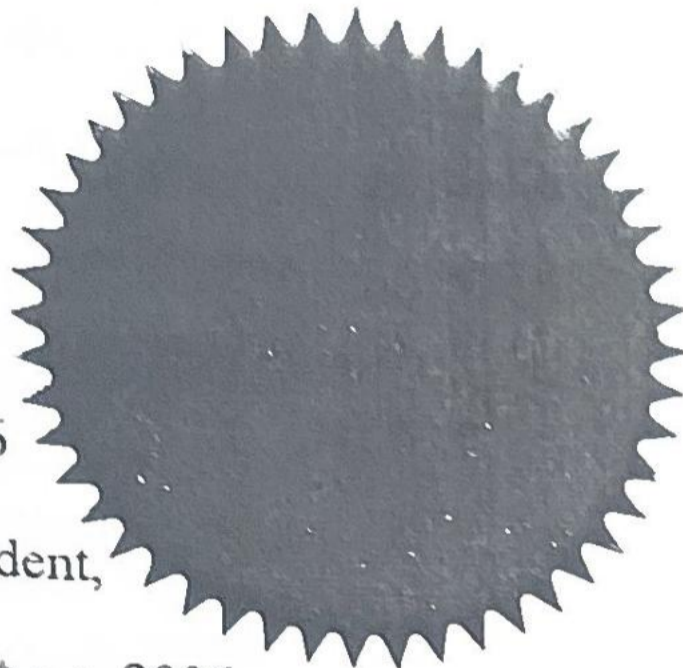



AN ACT to provide for the payment of gratuities to members of the Cabinet and for matters connected therewith.

[see section 1]

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Cabinet Members (Payment of Gratuities) Act, 2006 and is deemed to have come into force on 21st December 2001.

Cabinet Members (Payment of Gratuities) Act, 2006

Payment of gratuities

2. A member of the Cabinet who has served for a period of not less than twelve months shall be paid a gratuity of twenty-five per cent of his or her annual salary and allowances for each completed year of service—

- (a) subject to subsection (2), when he or she ceases to be a member of the Cabinet; or
 - (b) after being a member of the Cabinet for the five year term of office of the President,
- whichever first occurs.

(2) A member of the Cabinet who—

- (a) resigns from office as President, Vice-President or Secretary of State (1); or
- (b) ceases to hold office under section 67, 70 (8) or 71 (5) of the Constitution of the Republic of The Gambia, as the case may be,

is not entitled to the gratuity provided for in subsection (1).

(3) For the avoidance of doubt, "Cabinet" consists of the President, Vice-President and Secretaries of State.
