AN ACT to amend the Registration of Shipping Act, and for matters connected therewith.

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Registration of Shipping (Amendment) Act, 2006.

Amendment of
Cap 68:06

2. The Registration of Shipping Act (in this Act referred to as "the principal Act") is amended as set out in this Act.

General amend-
ment

3. The principal Act is amended by substituting for -

(a) the word "Director-General" wherever it occurs, the word "Administration";

(b) the word "he" or "him", when used in relation to the Director-General, the word "it";

(c) the words "Minister responsible", the words "Secretary of State responsible"

(d) the words "Minister of Works and Communications", the words "Secretary of State";

(e) the words "Ministry of Finance", the words "Department of State for Finance and Economic Affairs"; and

(f) the words "Ministry of Works and Communications", the words "Department of State for Works, Construction and Infrastructure".

4. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by -

(a) deleting the definition of "Director General";

(b) inserting, in the proper alphabetical sequence, the following new definitions-


"Administration" means The Gambia Maritime Administration established under The Gambia Maritime Administration Act, 2006;

"Secretary of State" means The Secretary of State responsible for the administration of this Act;.

5. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended, by substituting for the word "Minister", the words "Secretary of State".


