

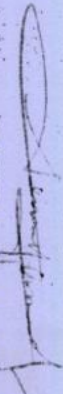
Public Service (Retiring Age) Act, 2004

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AN ACT to prescribe the retiring age in the public service of The Gambia and for matters connected therewith.

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ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Service (Retiring Age) Act, 2004.

2. In this Act, "public service" has the meaning assigned to it under section 166 (1) of the Constitution of the Republic of The Gambia, 1997.

Interpretation

3. (1) A person holding office in the public service of The Gambia -

(a) shall retire from that service on attaining the age of sixty years; and

(b) may retire from that service with an earned pension at any time after attaining the age of forty-five years.

4. The Pensions Act and any other law in force at the commencement of this Act containing provisions relating to the retiring age of public officers shall have effect with such modifications as may be necessary to bring them into conformity with and give full effect to the provisions of this Act.
