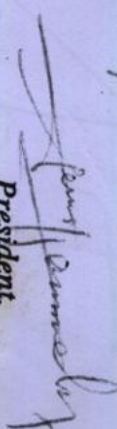

AN ACT to provide for the number of Secretaries of State to be appointed by the President and for matters connected therewith.

[1st March, 2002]

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Secretaries of State (Number) Act, 2002 and shall be deemed to have come into force on 1st March, 2002.

2. (1) The President shall appoint not more than twenty Secretaries of State, including the Attorney General, who shall be responsible for such Departments of State or other business of the Government as the President may assign to them.

(2) The qualifications for the appointment, removal from office and other functions of Secretaries of State are as set out in the provisions of the Constitution of the Republic of The Gambia.
