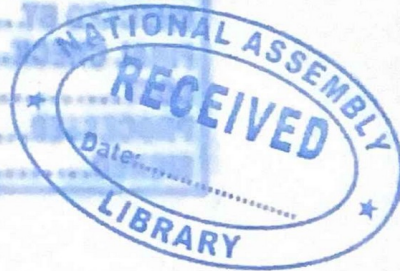

CHAPTER 49:02

NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR CIVIC EDUCATION ACT

An Act to establish the National Council for Civic Education and to make provision for connected matters.

[Act No. 1 of 1998.]

[Date of commencement: 16th April, 1998.]

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the National Council for Civic Education Act.

2. Interpretation

In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

“**Council**” means the National Council for Civic Education; and

“**Minister**” means the Minister for the time being responsible for the administration of this Act.

3. Establishment

(1) There is hereby established the National Council for Civic Education.

* (2) The members of the Council appointed under section 198 of the Constitution shall hold office for five years and shall be eligible for re-appointment for at least one term.

(3) A member of the Council may resign his or her office by notice in writing to the President.

4. Meetings

(1) The Chairperson of the Council shall preside at all meetings of the Council and in his or her absence any other member nominated by the members present shall preside.

(2) The quorum at every meeting of the Council shall be three.

(3) The decisions of the Council shall be determined by a majority of those present and voting, but where the votes are equally divided, the Chairperson shall have a casting vote.

5. Secretary

There shall be a Secretary to the Council who shall be appointed by the Council.

* Section 198 of the Constitution referred to in section 3 (2) above was deleted and replaced by a new section 198 by Act No. 6 of 2001.

6. Remuneration

The members of the Council shall receive such remuneration, fees and allowances as may be determined by the Minister.

7. Salaries and other expenditure

The administrative expenses of Council including salaries, allowances and pensions payable to, or in respect of persons serving the Council shall be a charge upon the Consolidated Fund.

8. Regulations

The Council may make regulations to give effect to the provisions of this Act.
