

Amendment of the Constitution

2..-(1) The Constitution of The Republic of Gambia, 1997 (in this Act referred to as "the Constitution") is amended by -

- (a) deleting the words "Secretary of State" in section 230 (1) and substituting for them, the word "Minister"
- (b) substituting for the words "Secretary of State" wherever it occurs in the Constitution, the word "Minister";
- (c) substituting for the words "Department of State" wherever it occurs in the Constitution, the word "Ministry".

(2) Section 71 is amended by substituting subsection (1), the following new subsection-

"There shall be such number of Ministers including the Attorney General, as the President may consider necessary".
