

(3) The Minister shall, not later than three months after the end of the financial year, cause the report to be laid before the National Assembly.

(4) The Director-General shall also, from time to time, provide the Minister with such information relating to the affairs of the Authority as the Minister may request.

Exemption from duties

22. The Authority shall be exempted from such duties as the Minister responsible for finance may approve.

## PART VI – LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

Notice of legal action

23. (1) An action may not be brought against the Authority unless at least one month's written notice of the intention to bring the action has been served on the Authority by the intending plaintiff or his or her agent.

(2) The notice shall state the cause of action, the name and place of abode of the intending plaintiff and the relief, which he or she claims.

24. In an action or suit against the Authority-

(a) execution or attachment or process in the nature of an execution or attachment shall not be issued against the Authority; or

(b) sums of money which may by judgment of the court be awarded against the Authority, shall not be paid by the Authority from its funds,

Execution of judgment

before the expiration of at least three months from the date of judgment of the court.

25. In a suit against the Authority, it may be represented in court at any stage of the proceedings by an officer or any other employee of the Authority duly authorized in writing by the Authority in that behalf.

26. An officer of the Authority or a person acting on the direction of the Authority is not personally liable in respect of a matter or thing done by him or her in good faith for the purposes of this Act.

## PART VII- MISCELLANEOUS

27. (1) Where a book, other than a book of such description as the Director-General may, from time to time, specify, is published by or on behalf of any person or Government Department in The Gambia, that person or head of Department shall, for the purpose of the Authority, deliver to the Director-General two copies of the book.

(2) The copies referred to in subsection (1) shall be-

(a) complete copies of the whole book with all maps, illustrations, finishing and colouring appearing in the same manner as the best copies of the book; and

(b) bound, sewed or stitched together on the best paper on which the book is printed.
