

(3) A person who fails to comply with this section commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding five thousand dalasis and in addition shall be ordered to deliver to the Director General two copies of the book in question.

Regulations

28. The Minister may, on the recommendation of the Authority, make regulations generally for the better carrying out of the purposes of this Act.

Repeal and savings
Cap. 48:04

29. (1) The Gambia Library Board Act is repealed and the Board established under it is consequentially dissolved.

(2) All Regulations, Orders, and Notices made or issued under the repealed Act, in so far as they are not inconsistent with this Act, shall remain in force until they lapse or are revoked.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), all purchases and acquisitions made under the repealed enactment are deemed to have been made under this Act.

(4) As from the commencement of this Act, all the rights, assets, liabilities and obligations of the dissolved Board existing immediately before the commencement of this Act shall be transferred to the Authority.

(5) As from the commencement of this Act, all the publications deposited under the repealed enactment are deemed to be deposited under this Act.

(6) Any action or proceeding in a court, or any judgment, decision or order that was enforceable by or against the dissolved Board immediately before the commencement of this Act may be continued and enforced by or against the Authority.
